

Paolo Cappello tells us about his work with our LAB for the development of his projects

How did you become acquainted with and what convinced you about working with Menotti Spec-

The partnership started as a kind of challenge. As a designer, I have always worked in 3D. So I wanted to see how it would be in 2D, attempting to bring the same vision and logic I use in my interior decoration projects to the creation of wood flooring.

The communication potential in wood flooring is boundless but only marginally exploited by the design world. We are used to conceiving parquet flooring as a set of planks laid side by side according to standard patterns that differ only in the type of wood used. By working also

The inspiration can be a shadow, a shape, a word that triggers a complex process consisting of infinite revisions, changes and second thoughts, all the way to the final product. What has inspired innovative products such as Compass, Nuage and Sablier?


I would begin with the names, because this is one of the most complex phases of the entire project development.

A name must immediately evoke the initial idea that is behind the concept, and this means that the answer to your question is quite simple, really.

Compass was inspired by the needle of marine compasses.

Nuage comes from the observation of the sinuous shapes of cloud formations

Sablier is the two-dimensional transposal of the shape of an hourglass. All of these floors share the fact of being inspired by elements linked to time and space. I like to have a common thread running through my projects, which also allows the more observant to see the bigger picture behind the various collections.




